

Shakopee Public Schools

Beginning **Wednesday, March 18**, Shakopee Public Schools will provide food services in a new way. The district wide meal pickup and meal delivery via school bus are being made available to all children.

Starting **March 18, 2020**, until further notice, food distribution for all children will be available in two ways:

Districtwide meal pickup: Shakopee Public Schools will distribute bag lunches for all children in a drive-up fashion from 11 a.m.-1 p.m. at Shakopee High School. The food pickup is located on the north side of the building (17th Avenue).

Meal delivery via school bus: Shakopee Public Schools is partnering with Palmer Transportation to drop-off meals at locations throughout the district. Meals will be delivered to the following areas from 11 a.m.-11:30 a.m. Monday through Friday:

- Mobile Manor
- Jackson Heights
- Bonnevista Terrace
- Valley Haven
- Eagle Creek Townhomes
- Sarazin Flats Apartments
- Clifton Townhomes
- Sweeney Elementary
- Pearson Elementary
- East Middle School

Jordan Public Schools

Student Food Options for **Wednesday, March 18 and Thursday, March 19 ONLY**

We will be providing two pickup options for student meals on the dates above. Meals will be FREE and are offered to ALL students from **Jordan Public Schools and St. John's**.

Location #1: Jordan High School

- Grab and Go Meals
- Drive up located on the west side of the building near the activities entrance (student lot)
- 11:00am-12:00pm

Location #2: Valley Green Community Center lot

- Grab and Go Meals
- Valley Green Community Center lot (bus will deliver meals)
- 11:00am-12:00pm

ANY student can go to either location to pick up a meal. Students **MUST BE** present to receive a meal. There will be no meals available over Spring Break. The district is discussing a new plan to begin on **Monday, March 30** (start of COVID-19 Distance Learning) based on guidance from the state.

Belle Plaine Public Schools

The Belle Plaine Public Schools will be providing meals for all students who request food service. The following is the process we will be following to provide food service:

1. We are sharing a survey with families to have them sign up for meals
2. We are communicating with families regarding school meals via email, Schoology, BP website, and Facebook.
3. We will deliver meals via bus routes (182 regular ed stops/12 SPED routes), grab and go at Belle Plaine High School.
4. We will deliver 2 meals during one drop time during mid-day breakfast and lunch.

Starting on **Wednesday, March 18, 2020**, we will be offering grab and go meals for students at the high school. You can pick up the meals from 10 am -1:00pm. If you are interested in your child receiving a lunch and breakfast meal, please fill out this SURVEY.

Starting on **Thursday, March 19, 2020**, we will be offering meals via grab and go to the high school from 10 am-1 pm every weekday and to the bus stops 4 hours later than the normal bus stop time every weekday. For example, if the bus normally picks up your child at 7:20 am the meal will be delivered at approximately 11:20 am. Due to this being a new procedure, please allow a few minutes for the bus to arrive.

Only parents, guardians, and children can pick up the meals. There will be only 1 meal package given to each child. If you are using the grab and go option at the high school, please remind your child the expectation is to pick up the meal package and leave the school immediately. Please remind your child to use extreme caution at the bus stops to ensure their safety.

If you qualify for free/reduced this opportunity will continue. If you pay for your meals the cost of the meal will be deducted from your account.

If you are part of the Belle Plaine Schools backpack program, this is now being offered through the food shelf.

Burnsville- Eagan Savage School District

District 191 will provide Grab-and-Go meals for any child ages 1 to 18 starting on **Wednesday, March 18** and continuing on weekdays through at least **Friday, March 27**.

Meals will be available for curbside pickup at two locations from **11 a.m.- 1 p.m.**

- Nicollet Middle School (Door #20 near front entrance), 400 E. 134th St., Burnsville, MN 55337
- Eagle Ridge Middle School (by the pool entrance), 13955 Glendale Road, Savage, MN 55378

Children may receive 2 meals each day (1 breakfast and 1 lunch per child per day). Children must be physically present to receive meals. Those who are sick or experiencing symptoms should not pick up meals.
