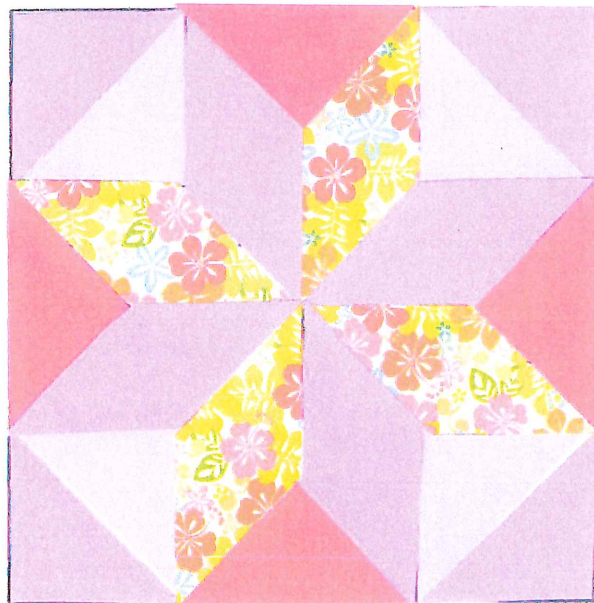
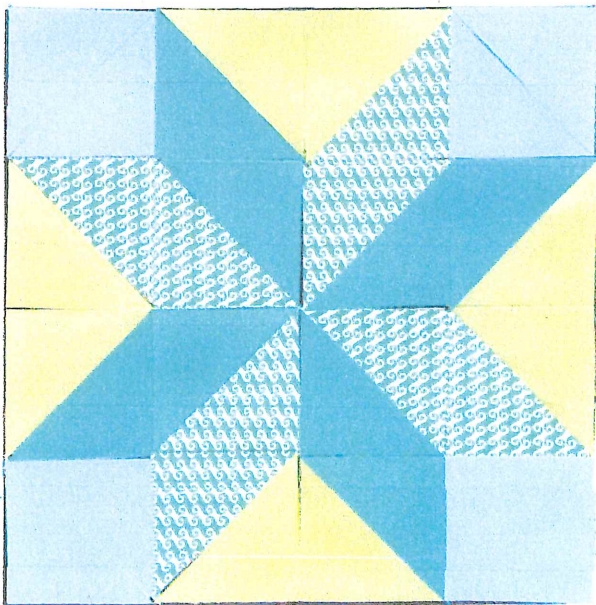


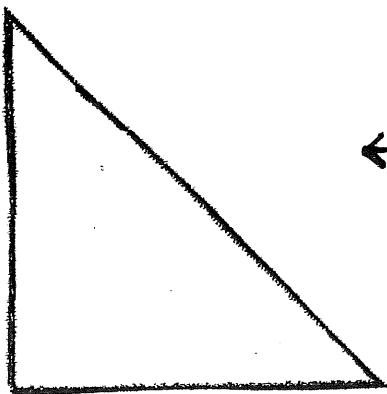
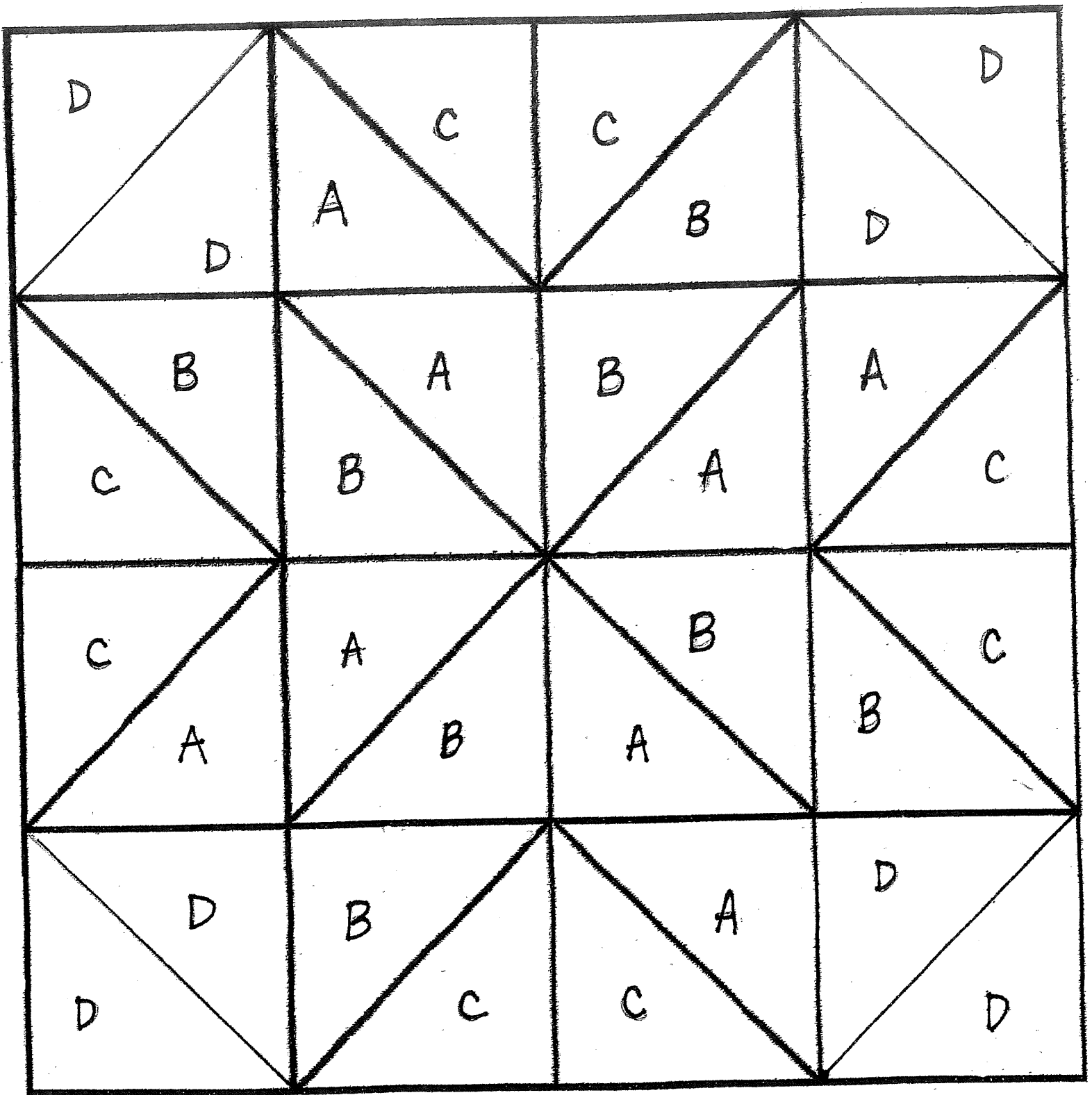
Paper Quilts

Supplies: 2 cardstock templates, solid and patterned paper, glue stick

You will need scissors.

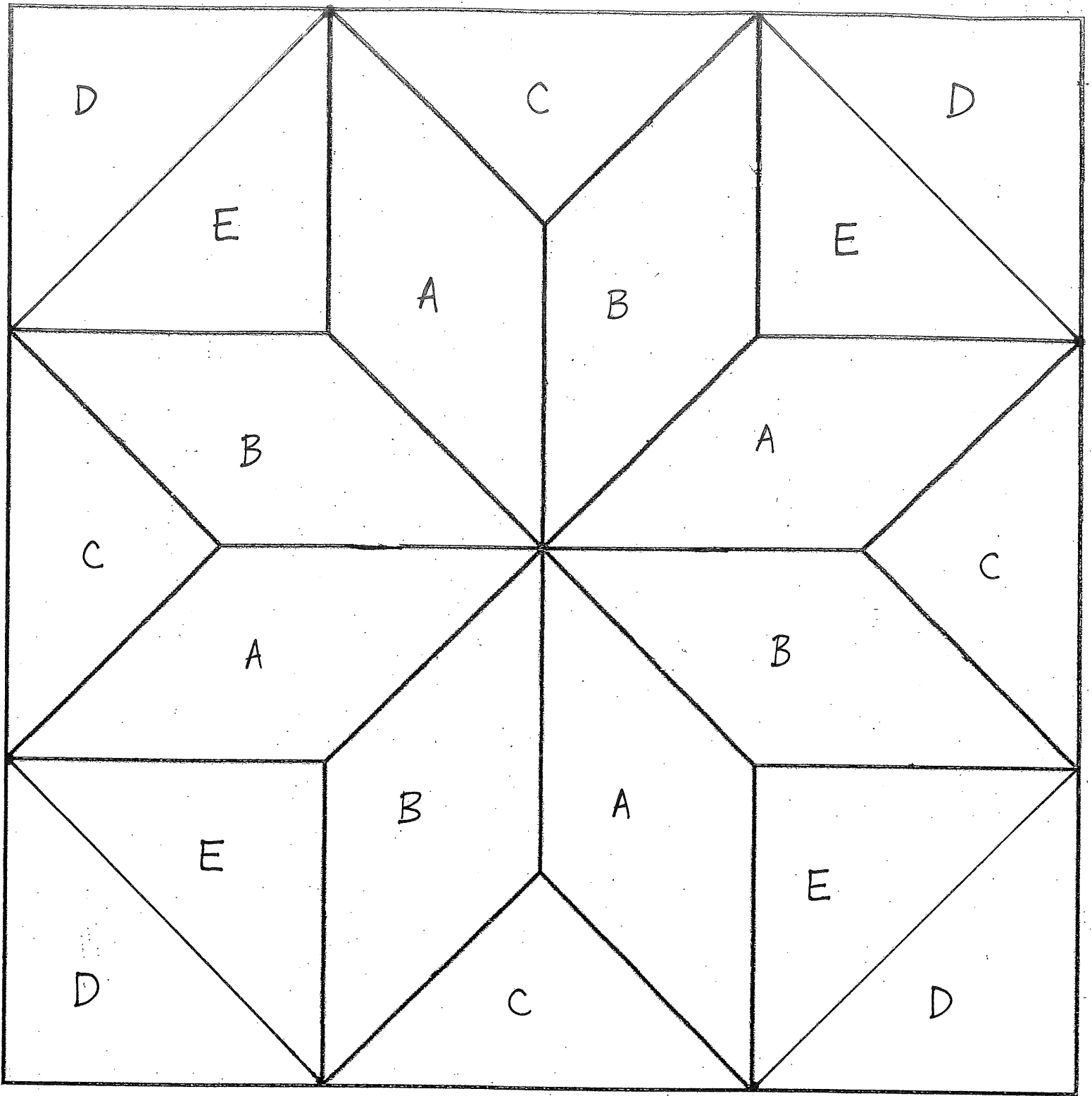
1. Choose a quilt template and cut out the pattern templates at the bottom of the page.
2. Choose 4 different pieces of paper for each quilt. In the samples, 3 solids and 1 patterned paper are used per quilt. It is up to YOU what you choose to use! Lay different combinations together to see what you like the best.
3. Each template piece has a letter that corresponds with a place on the quilt. Cut the number of pieces listed on the pattern template.
4. Lay out your pieces on the quilt template. When you are happy with the placement, use the glue stick to attach the pieces to the quilt template. Glue adjacent pieces at the same time (rather than all of one color) so that you can overlap a bit as needed.
5. You can leave a white border around your finished quilt or trim it up to the edge of the quilt.
6. Place finished quilts under a heavy book to help them dry flat.

Choose 3 solid colors and 1 patterned paper.
 Cut 8 triangles out of each piece of paper
 for a total of 32 triangles.
