Emmalie has been busy moving into the newly renovated Law Library space this week. She continues to unpack and get settled.

Emmalie has been focusing on providing programs to the public. She has been working hard to promote Community Mediation Minnesota's resources to both landlords and individuals facing eviction, often unrepresented. Community Mediation Minnesota has directly received grant funds that allow them to offer services to Scott County residents. Emmalie has been sending mailers to unrepresented landlords and individuals facing evictions providing them a link to a webpage with resources and a flyer for Community Mediation Minnesota. Emmalie has been tracking data and has seen an increase in individuals who follow through with Mediation Court.

The Jail Resource Center project continues to move forward. Emmalie will be providing an initial presentation to the various groups in the jail on May 18<sup>th</sup>. She has requested to be on site and available at the jail bi-monthly to help both inmates and staff with gaps in release support services.

Now that Emmalie can move into her new space, she is evaluating her collection for her 2022 budget. Consensus was that likely not much is needed in the collection since a lot of visitors come to either talk with the Law Librarian or utilize online resources provided by the Law Library. Emmalie will pull together a resource area/list for pro se individuals to utilize and work with Chris to think about how the space might be utilized or set up differently.
