- Legal Clinics
 - Alli is moving forward with a full schedule of offerings as well as exploring additional opportunities to add new clinics and additional timeslots. There has been a lot of interest in the clinics from customers, but volunteer attorneys are busy, so it is hard to meet demand.
 - Alli started a new intake process which has been helpful for both customers and volunteer attorneys and seems to be resulting in a higher rate of customers who show up for their appointments.
- Brochures
 - The Law Library brochure has been updated with recent information and Alli has had both the brochure and resource offering packet translated into Spanish as well.
- Family Resource Center
 - Alli has been visiting the FRC for their open houses and would like to eventually work up to having time there for helping customers once a week or so. FRC staff refers clients to the Law Library often.
- LL Event- MACV
 - MACV is a Veterans resource group. Alli is excited to partner and offer a one stop shop for veterans on June 1st from 10 a.m. – 1 p.m. She is busy working with other departments and resources in the county to prepare for the event. More details to come!
- Customer Data
 - Alli has been looking back at data from earlier this year that reflects how many customers came into the Law Library, what issues they were seeking help with how many were representing themselves, etc. There has been a steady increase in the number of individuals coming to the Law Library in recent months.
- ARPA Grant
 - The decision was made to not move forward with ARPA grant funds to implement a Law Library at the jail. Jail staff indicated there is not an immediate need for that right now. If we decide to pursue this in the future, we can apply for other grants.
- Collaborating/networking
 - Alli has been meeting with staff in other county departments to build collaboration and understanding of what resources and services the Law Library provides and pave the way for future events.
- New Programs
 - Alli is working hard to work with others in the county to bring in new programs like MACV.
- Law Day
 - Law Day is on hold for the moment while Alli looks at numbers and continues to reach out to various individuals in the county about collaborating on a possible event.
- Warrant Day
 - Mary Freyberg started Warrant Day a number of years ago and Alli is exploring the possibility of bringing this back but needs to be thoughtful of Court Administration's calendar which has been overloaded since COVID. More details to come!
- Inmate meetings
 - Alli has seen an increase in inmate questions and requests. She has been providing forms and doing more meetings with inmates lately. The Jail staff have been very helpful.
