ATOD Update:

- No current updates from ATOD or opioid work

SHIP Update:

- 3rd week of Veggie RX 42 households and about the same at RVHS in Carver County (~200 people served)
- Working with gardens new gardens with Moms on a Mission and Correctional Facility
- Farmers Market within the county- working with them to accept SNAP/EBT as a focus for SHIP work. Handful of markets accepting WIC vouchers (3 WIC- Savage, Little Market that could Prior Lake, and New Prague Farmers Market)
 - Will we include WIC on this as well? Yes that is the plan to start advertising sooner so markets can get the training required
- SHIP is working with a new partner, Gathering Pines YMCA who is doing Farm at the Arb
- SHIP is currently working on their application revamp for the 2022-2023 grant year which will start on November 1st, 2023
- MEDA is wrapping up which has supported Bringing Down the Numbers Diabetes Prevention Program, Mi C.A.S.A. with food distributions, Zumba classes, Soccer program, and their food pantry.

Annie UCARE:

- The medical assistance application has reopened. So people may lose UCARE is now covering rides to apply for coverage

Lisa Brodsky:

- The outdoor fitness court is going to be happening. Fitness Court with exercise and side with outside yoga- going in Shakopee with Scenic Park Heights- City of Shakopee- Partners UCARE, etc. Have some grants out there to get funding. Accessibility throughout the year
