Background/Information

Scott County, in partnership with the City of Prior Lake and the City of Savage, is starting concept development for improvements at the intersection of County Highway (CH) 42 and Trunk Highway (TH) 13, and its immediate area. Currently, the intersection is congested, signalized with a temporary system, and provides incomplete bike and/or pedestrian paths.

To alleviate these conditions, the proposed project adds dual left turn lanes on CH 42 at its TH 13 intersection, installs a permanent signal system at the intersection, and constructs a trail/sidewalk on CH 42 for bike and pedestrian connectivity.

Signal upgrades will also take place at the intersections of Rutgers St./CH 42 and Quebec Ave./CH 42, along with median reconstruction, access modifications, and pavement rehabilitation. Pavement rehabilitation extends from Boone Avenue to Louisiana Avenue, which marks the endpoints of the project. CH 42 is anticipated to remain open throughout the duration of the project.

Project Purpose/Goals

The purpose of the CH 42 and TH 13 intersection project is to improve the safety and mobility of drivers and pedestrians by investing in the intersection of these two important highways.

Goals of the project include the following:

- Improved safety and mobility for the intersection
- Meeting current traffic needs and accommodating long-term growth projections
- An inclusive public participation process

Open House #1: Project Kick-Off

At the open house, you will have the opportunity to:

1. Review the project process and schedule;
2. Identify existing concerns and issues at the intersection and its immediate area; and
3. Assist in developing potential solutions to existing and future problems in the project area.

This is an informal open house meeting. No presentation will be given. Your input will ensure the project team develops a comprehensive understanding of the issues along the corridor from those who use this intersection every day. County and city staff will be available to discuss issues and listen to your concerns. Maps and more information will be available for review.


