## UA Testing Form

As a condition of my pre-trial release, probation, or supervised release, I have been ordered to submit to random drug/alcohol testing. I am aware that I am responsible for calling the drug testing message line or logging in to <https://my.averhealth.com> every day between the hours of 4:00 AM and 6:00 PM to check if I am to test that day. I am required to listen to the entire message until I hear a confirmation number.

If I am instructed to test today, I must report to the Scott County Government Center West (200 Fourth Avenue West, Shakopee) Office GW-061. When entering the building at the Fourth Ave. entrance, take the stairs (or elevator) to your right down to the Lower Level - the office is on the left. Please follow the signage directing you how to check in.

**Testing hours are 10:00 AM – 6:00 PM Monday through Friday and 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM on weekends and holidays.**

**They accept cash, debit cards, and credit cards. They will NOT accept personal checks. Contact your agent for information on the cost of the test.**

**I understand that I am not allowed to “make-up” a test if I fail to test on the day I am required. Failure to submit on the day I am required could lead to a sanction/revocation.**

If you fail to get through on the call-in line the first time, continue to call until you get through.

### IMPORTANT TESTING INFORMATION

- If you do not have payment, you will not be tested.
- A photo ID is required to test. If you do not have a photo ID, you will not be tested.
- Please be prepared to notify collectors of any medications that you are currently using.
- EtG testing will detect alcohol consumption. You are responsible to make sure that you do not consume any beverages which contain alcohol.

***If you do choose to test at one of these alternative sites or another of your choice, you are responsible to get the results of your tests to Scott County Community Corrections. These sites may also charge added fees for their tests which you will be responsible to pay.***
